To date, the Home First philosophy has been rolled out in multiple South West LHIN communities with positive results for clients and service providers. Coordinated Access to Assisted Living, Adult Day Programs, CCC and Rehabilitation has been initiated across the LHIN with multiple providers, using a staged implementation schedule so that the impact of this work can be well-understood. Efforts to re-align resources related to Adult Day Programs, CCC and Rehab continue with an emphasis on stakeholder engagement and with the added perspectives resulting from detailed recommendations concerning Convalescent Care and Restorative Care, as well as for Special Populations.
