

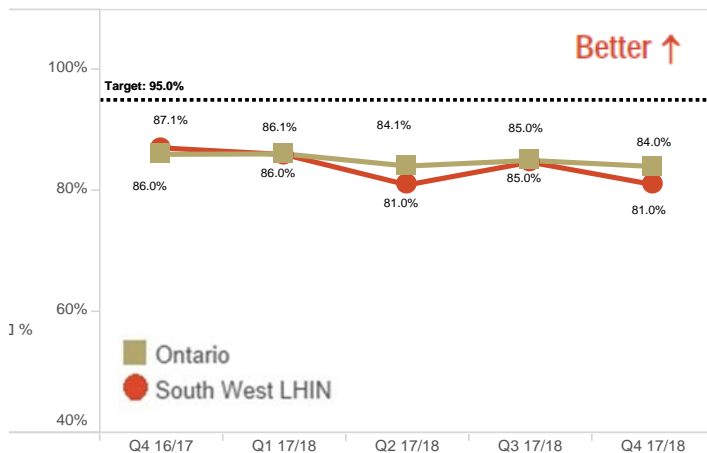


How Will We Know We Have Been Successful?

- More people with palliative care needs being supported at home

How Are We Doing?

#25. Percentage of Palliative Care Clients Discharged From Hospital With Home Support



- Four out of every five palliative care patients identified in the South West LHIN are being discharged from hospital to home-based settings with supportive care in place
- Discharges from hospital to home with palliative support declined slightly in Q4 17/18
- In Q1 17/18, 89% of palliative patients died in their place of choice with the majority of deaths occurring in home and residential hospice
- In Q4 17/18, the average occupancy in residential hospices was over 90% at two of three sites

What Is Impacting Performance?

Initiating & Planning

- **Expansion of Residential Hospice** – Continued expansion of residential hospice capacity for Huron Perth and Grey Bruce and Elgin
- **Palliative Education** - Spread of early identification strategies including Advanced Care Planning and Gold Standards Framework
- **Indigenous-led Coordinated Palliative Care Pathway** - An Indigenous-led early test of change for culturally safe coordinated palliative care planning is currently participating in Cohort 12 of the IDEAS Advanced Learning Program

Executing

- **Expansion of Residential Hospice (Grey Bruce)** - A two-bed expansion to newly constructed Chapman House was completed in Q1 17/18. One additional bed will be added at Chapman House later in FY 17/18
- **Secondary Level Outreach** - Community-based Secondary Level Palliative Care Outreach Consultation Teams are fully operational in Grey Bruce, Huron Perth, Oxford, and Elgin sub-regions. A Palliative Care Outreach model is being developed for Indigenous communities in London Middlesex and Grey Bruce

Potential Future Opportunities and Considerations

- The Palliative Care Capacity report was refreshed in Q2 17/18. Recommendations will include a focus to guide the alignment of palliative care services planning to the *Ontario Palliative Care Network's Action Plan 1: 2017-2020*, released November 2017
